

EURACT Membership fees - 2019

Fees are based on the country gross domestic product (GDP) at purchasing power parity (PPP) per capita (pc) as estimated by the IMF (International Monetary Fund). Countries are placed in the different “cells” according to these IMF-figures. Fees for a given year are normally based on newest data available in the year before (World Economic Outlook Database)

Countries with GDP at PPP pc of Curr. Int. \$ 25,000 – 34,999: fee of 30 Euro	Estonia, Greece, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Portugal, Russia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Turkey Total: 11 countries
Countries with GDP at PPP pc of Curr. Int. \$ 35,000 – 44,999: fee of 40 Euro	Cyprus, Czech Republic, Finland, France, Israel, Italy, Malta, Spain, United Kingdom Total: 9 countries
Countries with GDP at PPP pc of \geq Curr. Int. \$ 45,000: fee of 50 Euro	Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Germany, Iceland, Ireland, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland Total: 11 countries
